As the following chart shows, Henry Frantz (1773-1840), who settled in Montgomery County with his large family of 9 children, was a second cousin once removed of the Ohio pioneers, Christian and Daniel Frantz, and a third cousin to Nicholas Frantz. Henry Frantz was a great-grandson of Christian Frantz I (1685-1789) through the latter's son, Christian Frantz II (1706-1783), and his grandson, Christian Frantz III (1743-1783). Henry Frantz married ca1797 in Botetourt County, VA, Mary Kinzie (1777-1847), daughter of Christian Kinzie, Sr. Their children married into Eikenberry, Shock, Neff, Myers, Whitehead, Spitler, Rodabaugh, and Stauffer families. My genealogical index is not complete for a number of these Henry Frantz lines.

Your N & A were sent me by Phyllis B. Hanson of Albert Lea, MN, about a month ago. I may have written you previously, but can't find the carbon. So just in case, here goes again(?).

Lafayette is where I met my wife while we were in school at Purdue. Our first child was born there at Home hospital in 1956. So your town holds pleasant memories for me.

You have done some research on the Brechbühl/Brechbill/Brackbill families per Phyllis. Recently learned that Anna Brechbill (bapt. 6 Oct 1715 @ Trachselwald, Switz.) and Ulrich Engel, 1754 immigrants, are 5 gt grparents. I would appreciate any references you can send me for learning more about these people. My source is the 1927 History of the Engle Family by M. H. Engle, a confusedly-written and -organized little genealogy.

Do you have any Shock ancestors? In my possession is my Gma Mylin's book, Descendants of Adam Shock, published privately in 1911 by Joseph H. Shock of Lafayette, IN. Gma was Mary Ellen Shock (1874-1936) of Wabash, IN. A daughter of Adam Shock was Barbara (Shock) Frantz (1809-1876) who md. Christel Frantz and had 11 children. Only one of many sons grew to adulthood and married. He was William Frantz, b. 1852, m. Sarah Walden. Shocks lived Montgomery Co OH.

If you believe there is opportunity for us to cooperate in this interesting search, please write. I belong to NEHGS, which has a 300,000 vol. library of local history and genealogy. Also, free access to the Census allows me to look up entries for correspondents.
