In The Studebaker Family in America 1736-1976, neither the parentage of Nancy Frantz (1825-1902) who married Samuel Steele Studebaker and became the mother of his 16 children, nor of Jacob Frantz (1824-1914), who married Samuel's sister, Phoebe Studebaker, were identified. Both were among the 12 children of Benjamin and Elizabeth (Flory) Frantz, Benjamin being a son of Daniel Frantz (1763-1843). In July, 1937, May Miller Frost, in company with Miss May Garst, of Salem, Va., consulted the Courthouse records and located the farm of David Peffley, now owned by John Morris, a court reporter, Roanoke, Va. In a hickory grove back of the present house were located the graves of David and Magdalena. They are at the foot of a hickory tree, and are marked with slabs of native slate, with the following inscriptions chiseled thereon:

"D. P. was born Feb. 15th in the year 1761. Dide Dec. 14th, 1827"

"Magdalena Peffy was born Jan. 11th, 1763. And dide Apr. 1st 1829."

Anna Garst Frantz was buried at Brook's Grove Cemetery, near Stanford, Ill.

On page 451, History of Church of the Brethren, we find John Frantz, the ninth of Anna's eleven children was baptized in 1822, elected deacon in 1827, to the ministry in 1833, ordained in 1847. Following the death of Elder Ebersole in 1850, was given charge of the church, and served as Bishop until 1877. He died on the homestead now occupied by his daughter Phoebe Lane.

Frederick Garst, I, and Christian Zehring (born 1755) served as privates in Capt. Casper Stoevers company, 3rd of 2nd Battalion, Lancaster County, Penn., Militia 4th Class in 1781 and 1782. They married sisters.

The family Bible of Frederick Garst, I, is a German-language edition, published in 1790 in Germantown (presumably in Germany). It came down through the Anna Garst-Gordon line to its present owner, Mrs. C. B. Smith, Rt. 2, Jamestown, Ohio. It has a leather binding and brass clasp, and the paper is very brittle. It has a limited number of dates and historical items, such as this entry by John Gordon, Sr., July 10, 1859: "This book sent to my mother by her father Frederick Gharst, about the year 1830. He died about the age of 90 years." And this, "My mother deceased at the age of 73 years, 2 months and 20 days, Oct. 22, 1858." And this, "My father deceased Dec. 17, 1857, aged 83 yrs., 7 days." All written by Anna's historian son, John Gordon, Sr. Mrs. Smith keeps this Bible in her lock box at the bank—it's that precious!

Frederick Garst's boyhood was doubtless spent on his father's 174-acre farm in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, though the details of those early years are entirely lacking. In the year 1778, he married Magdalena Rauch, daughter of John Rauch (Rough or Raugh), on whose farm George Washington and his soldiers camped in the Revolutionary War. Frederick served in Captain Casper Stoever's Company, 8th Class, Second Battalion, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania Militia, in the year 1781. Frederick's brother, John Nicholas Garst, Jr., also served in Capt. Stoever's Company, 7th Class, Second Battalion, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, Militia, in 1781. Their cousin, Dewalt Garst, Jr., served in Capt. John Gossert's Company, First Class, 8th Co., Second Battalion, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, probably Bethel Twp. Reference Pennsylvania Archives, 5th Series, Vol. 7, page 162. Following his honorable discharge, Frederick Garst, I, and his young bride and his brothers, Jacob and John Nicholas, Jr., and others migrated to southwest Virginia. It was a long and dangerous trip in covered wagons, following Indian trails down through the Shenandoah Valley into the Blue Ridge Mountains. These brothers located only a few miles apart, and there they felled the virgin forest and built their log houses.

The old Indian Garst Fort is located about three and one-half miles from Salem, Va., in the Green Ridge neighborhood, and was formerly the home of Frederick Garst, I, better known as Indian Garst, because of his fame in Indian Conflicts. This Fort is built entirely of hand-hewn white-oak logs on a sandstone foundation. The building is about 24x30 feet, built over a very large spring; which assured abundance of water during an attack. Alongside of it, in the basement, were stored provisions to last for weeks in event of siege. The basement ceiling is 10 feet high. The walls of rock are cemented together with a mortar of clay and lime. The foundation logs are two feet square and become somewhat smaller as the walls extend upward. All the logs of this three-story structure above the basement are perfectly dove-tailed together and fastened with wooden pins, as are the rafters. The floors are also hand-hewn, with a narrow stairway to the upper floors. Peep-holes were used in watching and repelling the attacking Indians. Now only one of these remains—the others being replaced with windows.

The door and window frames, hinges, shutters, and locks were hand made. The first and second stories have four rooms each. Partitions and other interior lumber in the fort are sawed white-oak

boards 16 inches wide and 1½ inches thick. A leaking roof has caused the logs on the upper half of third floor to decay. They have now been removed, and roof lowered, to a 6½ foot ceiling.

This building, one of the oldest in Roanoke County, is in the hands of a private owner, who threatens to tear down and sell the logs. A great pity!

Indian raids were numerous. The settlers were in constant dread of the war whoop as those savage tribes, moving from east to west on their well-known Indian trails where were committed numerous depredations. Botetourt County, named after a famous English nobleman extended from the present eastern border to the Ohio River, and included all of Kentucky, with Fincastle, Va., as the county seat. Tradition has it that when past middle-age, Frederick made a trip on foot from Virginia back to his old home in Pennsylvania. He has been described as somewhat eccentric, though very brave and fearless.

In the spring of 1842, Frederick Garst, I, was found dead at the foot of a high cliff of rock, and the general belief is that he accidentally fell from the top of the cliff. It is known that he spent much of his time late in life in hunting . . . his hobby.

About three miles from Salem, Va., on the summit of a hill, on the farm of Rev. John H. Garst, are located the graves of Frederick and Magdalena Garst, in a private Garst Burying Ground, now covered with honey-suckle vines. On the wide head-stone is carved:

FREDERICK GARST
of Indian Fame
1752—1842

MAGDALENA GARST
nee Rauch
1752—1845

AT REST

Frederick Garst, I, is reputed to be the man who, in legendary fiction, was splitting logs high up in the timber when he found himself surrounded by six husky Indians. He asked them, "You come to scalp me?" "Yes," was the answer. "Well, you have me. I can't get away." He persuaded them to help split the log in which he had a wedge, before they killed him. They agreed, and he asked them to get three on each side, put their fingers in the crack and pull while he hit the wedge. They were pulling hard when he knocked the wedge out and the log closed on their fingers. Then the ax was used on them—gruesome, but saved his life. This is a matter of history, and was formerly in some of the early histories of America.

And whereas in pursuance of sundry proceedings had in the Orphans court of Dauphin County the said tract of land was separated and divided into two divisions or shares. And one whereof being bounded by Bow Runlands of John Todd, James Todd and the other part of said tract, was valued and appraised at and for the sum of eleven hundred and eighty one pounds and ten shillings the same containing one hundred and thirty nine acres and the usual allowances which said part or share was taken by Peter Rough one of the sons of the deceased, and was adjudged and confirmed to him by the said Court he paying or securing to be paid thereout the respective shares of the other children of the said deceased, and the interest of three hundred and ninety pounds, sixteen shillings and five pence that being the one third of the valuation thereof, to the widow of said deceased yearly and every year during her natural life as in and by the records and proceedings of the said Court may more appear.

Now know ye that the said Frederick Gerst and Mattalina his wife for and in consideration of the sum of eighty six pounds sixteen shillings and nine pence lawful money of Pennsylvania to them in hand paid by the aforesaid Peter Rough at and before the ensealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and forever discharge the said Peter Rough his heirs Executors and administrators by these presents.

Have remised released and forever quit claimed and by these presents do remise and forever quit claim unto the said Peter Rough and to his heirs and assigns all the estate rights title interest property claim and demand whatsoever of them the said Frederick Gerst and Mattalina his wife in law or equity or otherwise howsoever of in or

out of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and thirty nine acres and allowance, part of the larger tract aforesaid. . . . etc.

He then bought the John Garver farm, which he carried on for two years, when he returned to his present farm, buying the land from his father. Here he has since been engaged in general agriculture, and has spent considerable time and money in improving the land, remodeling the old brick house and other buildings on the farm.

Mr. Frantz was married October 14, 1879, to Dora Markey, of Preble County, Ohio, and thirteen children have been born of this union, namely: Verna, wife of J. Aukerman, who has one child—Forest; Benjamin A., who married Dora Brubaker; Edith, who married James Shoup; Maude, wife of E. Onkst; Markey, Anna, Emma, Evelyn, Martin, Pauline, and three others who died in infancy.

Mr. and Mrs. Frantz are members of the old German Baptist Brethren Church, in which Mr. Frantz's father is an elder and preaches in the Honey Creek Church.

MICHAEL RADER, township trustee and owner of a farm of ninety-five and three-quarters acres, located about six miles northwest of Springfield, on the Eureka Road, just off the Troy Turnpike, is one of the enterprising and influential agriculturists of German Township. He was born December 9, 1868, on a farm in Springfield Township, Clark County, Ohio, and is a son of Philip and Margaret (Sultz) Rader.

Philip Rader was born and reared to manhood in Germany and after coming

to Clark County worked a farm now owned by Wil. While visiting his sister in Missouri, he met and married Sultz, who was born in Germany and came to America with his father, settled in St. Louis. Dear Mrs. Frantz,

I received ~~your~~^{your} letter a few days ago and find myself at some loss as to what I should reply. You mentioned in your letter about me going south. I have no idea where you learned that we have been living at Sebring, Fla. for several years and since my wife passed away last November I did go down in January and plan to go south again this winter but do not have any date set.

Having two homes is very nice but also very inconvenient. I lack quite a bit of being an accomplished genealogist but I do have some materials and I find it next to impossible to move everything with me when I go either north or south. Consequently, some one is always asking for material that is not with me. Last year I brought a very little HEETER material with me and soon was asked to write material for the Brethren Encyclopedia on the HEETER name. I was able to borrow some material from a Heeter relative in N. Manchester.

All of the above to inform you that I have very little FRANTZ material here. Some one suggested that I have duplicate sets of materials which could be kept at either address and then the only material I would need to move would be the material I acquired at either place. I would like that idea if I had ready access to a xerox machine. One of my granddaughters has expressed an interest in my material when I am no longer around and it is doubtful if she would have need for duplicate copies of everything I have, especially since she is only 26 years of age and will not likely be having two homes for many years.

I had heard of the Oct. 3rd meeting at Timbercrest and was hoping I would be able to be there. My interest in the Frantz name is not as great as it might be since the closest relative of that name I have was a great grandmother. But I am still interested.

My feeling is that each grandparent should write something for his or her descendants which should in part be historical, but could relate interesting incidents as well as trying times and successes also. In addition to genealogy and my biography-autobiography self-assignment, I have been a philatelist for more than 60 years and I am physically blessed with good health and I can always find things my family would like me to do for them.
