Dear Rosemary,

I'm shying away from genealogy for several months - been at it so long, that I need a rest. And now that I'm married with two little children, Gareth is 21 months and Saloma is 2 months, -- I feel they are my present priority.

In fact, I'm putting away all requests for a long time, perhaps 5-6 years. For 20 some years, I received a letter of some sort, wanting something from someone! almost everyday

Re. - Blocher --- I know Lee Small of Germany is tracing Blocher. And what she has, she mainly has secured from me. I've been at that line since age 10 or 11 (from my own fascinating grandmother, Eliza Blocher Beachler), and Lee just started a year or so ago. Now there are several wanting to do Blocher into a book genealogy. For 20 some years, only ones interested were me and old people in their 80s and 90s, now all gone. And now is bad timing for me to do anything with it. I know these younger ones feel I'm mean. ha Lee (Leona is her correct name) is related to me, her grandfather John Blocher and my greatgrandfather, Isaac (oldest and youngest of 13) were brothers. Her Dad and my Dad grew up together in North Dakota and were the best of friends.

Re. - Bollinger --- I always did think that 1756 was the wrong year for Abraham Bollinger. I gladly accept 1750 as more accurate.

Re. - Frantz ---- Did I understand you correctly that there is a RESEARCHER for the Michael Frantz 11 family. Who is he? For years, I was hoping there would be one.

No doubt I told you before, my beloved foster grandmother, Mary Flory Cover, was from Michael Frantz line, her mother was Leah Frantz of Clark County, Ohio. If there was ever an angel on earth, it was this Grandma Cover. Anyway, she loved genealogy and had endless amount of records, which s gave me, and her memory was excellent. I think she was the smartest woman I ever knew, and she had limited education.

So I have folders and folders of Michael Frantz data, and have added to it thru the years - mainly all in scribbled notes. Even an antique note book with Daniel Frantz's own writings of ancestry in it. I loaned it to a Mormon cousin a few years ago and they burnt part of it in microfilming. Made me sick. Nevertheless, I have it back.

So if there is a Michael Frantz researcher, I would certainly be happy to share with him or her or whoever. And I still hope I can connect my poor ole Jacob Frantz ancestor back there, floating around without parents. Someone, I just feel he is the Jacob son of Michael and Magdalena. And I definitely know that his son John 1787-1872 was married to Barbara Arnett. Found two many records to verify this is correct, and even knew several grandchildren of them that well remembered them, back in my youth. They were old people and gave me so many records, mainly around North Manchester, Indiana.

Mohler is a common name among the German Baptist and the Brethren. I know Marcus Miller - author of "Roots by the River" personally. I could have added some data to his writings had I known beforehand. Grandpa Cover was partially reared at Covington, Ohio. Did I ever tell you I did their life story in book form when I was 19 years old - they have all been sold for years. The Cover and Mohler families intermarried repeatedly.

Still haven't added any clue to my Anna Frantz Beachler yet - of her parentage. Maybe when we get back to Va. again next year, I can pursue these researchings further especially in Botetourt County. That old courthouse there is a gold mine of genealogy. I was there just a few hours last year.

Dear Rosemary;

I am desperately trying to avoid genealogy now. But it seems so hard to do. In 1976, I was married and now we have three little children - so life does not give me a lot of time at the moment to devote to genealogy.

But it seems more has come my way these past few years than ever before - so maybe that it the way it goes! I do have all my Frantz and Brubaker and the such folders in much better shape and also organized.

We will be staying at my brothers farm house for several weeks, while they are east, so I am trying very hard this week to get letters answered and out of the way before we move out of our own house; during that time. A young girl will stay in our house. This way, our children can have the rest of the summer in the country.

But I did want to give you some Frantz data before your October 3rd discussion in North Manchester.

In reference to the Royer Genealogy (1915), page 225-230, is family of John Frantz born 1749. In the 1947 Waynesboro, Penna., book, is a claim that this John Frantz is of the Michael Frantz family. Then you might want to check with the Hochstetter book, page 937. Also, somewhere else, I was given that the Christian Frantz-Anna Frick family dated back to the John Frantz of the Michael Frantz family. I saw a Frick record in New York in 1962, and this might be where I got it. Anyway, I see from your records, you have this family in the Baltzer Frantz family.

Your Elizabeth Bollinger Frantz - was a sister to my ancestor, Abraham Bollinger born 1756, and father of Isaac Bollinger, 1785-1861, who married Anna Blocher, and they were the parents of Catherine Bollinger Blocher 1822-1867.

My wife, formerly Doris Brubaker of Virginia, is descended from Anna Frantz Wertz, 1779-1836, wife of John Wertz, daughter of Christian Frantz 111 1743-1824. In the Matthias Frantz genealogy, it has her listed as Anna, born 1782, wife of Henry Wortz. That is incorrect.

I still can not locate the parentage of my ancestors --

John Frantz, born 1787 in Penna., son of Jacob Frantz married Barbara Arnett at Dayton, Ohio, moved to North Manchester in 1849 died Feb. 4, 1872, buried in old Frantz Cemetery

Anna Frantz, born 1791 in Virginia, married Frederick Beachler in Dayton, Ohio, lived in Clay Twp., Montgomery Co., Ohio, died 1871

So if you do come across any leads on John or Anna, I would appreciate it.

First of all, I'm enclosing Beachler and Frantz data - I'm trying to locate. So far I have not connected our Anna Frantz 1791-1871 (md. to Frederick Beachler) and our John Frantz 1787-1872 (md. to Barbara Arnet) -- to any of the Frantz families that I know about.

I have ordered a Mathias Frantz history of Penna. Have you seen the book?

Then - my foster grandmother - Mary Flory Cover, was descended from old Michael Frantz 1687-1748 from Switzerland.

Do you know anyone that is gathering data on this Michael Frantz family. If so, have them contact me - as I have <u>much</u> data on him, his sons, then the sons of Michael Frantz 11, and descendents. If there is a history being compiled by an individual or a group, I would gladly loan my Frantz files for reference, outline, etc.

Since I'm not a blood line of Michael Frantz family, I do not intend to do anything with the records - other than refer to them often for other lines I'm tracing, connecting into that family. Grandma Cover gave me much data on this family.

As far as I can find, our Anna Frantz and our John Frantz are not of this family, nor the Mathias Frantz family, nor of a Christian Frantz family that was sent to me. Anna and John surely weren't brothers and sister - if so, my great-grandparents were first cousins!



They lived on the old Frantz farm, but later moved to Sunfield, Mich., Wheatfield, Ind., and Surrey. N. D. where they died. Isaac Frantz married Lucinda Brown in 1865, left the same day for the Civil War, and died six months later.

# MARK HONEYWELL, WABASH'S FAMOUS SON

Mark C. Honeywell, born in Wabash Dec. 29, 1874, was the son of Mary Jane (Mariner) and Sanford Honeywell, a pioneer moving to Wabash from Pennsylvania in 1843 to establish the city's first tile mill for Robert Cissna. Later Mark engaged in the flour and cider mill business with his half-brother Charles Horace Launder. (One of the mill stones is preserved at Wabash PLAIN DEALER building, 123 W. Canal.).

Mark attended Wabash schools and Stetson University, Deland, Fla., where his father grew oranges. His first jobs were cutting wood for the fireplace (which led him, in later life, to build many fireplaces used for decoration only), growing, harvesting, marketing oranges until the 1895 freeze.

After that, he traveled about the South demonstrating bicylces. In 1899 he returned to Wabash, beginning a heating-contracting business, inventing automatic controls. He married Olive Lutz 1901. They were social and business leaders in Wabash, at Lake Wawasee and in Miami Beach, Fla. Olive Honeywell died after a fall in 1939 in their Boca Chita Island, Fla. house.

1906 Mark founded Honeywell Heating Specialty, merging in 1937 with his Minneapolis rivals to become Minneapolis-Honeywell Regulator Co., manufacturer of products of automation including many kinds of controls and thermostats. The industry, known after 1964 as Honeywell, Inc., had 47 plants in U. S., Canada, Europe, Asia and more than

### FREDERICK AND ANNA (FRANTZ) BEACHLER



Frederick Beachler was born in Bavaria, Germany.

To avoid military duty in that country, he came to the United States while still a young man.

His parents are unknown, also if he had brothers or sisters. Previous to his coming, several different Beachler families came from Germany. Most of them settled in Pennsylvania, then migrated to Montgomery County, Chio.

Perhaps Frederick was related to the other Beachler families, as he came directly to Dayton, Ohio, upon arriving from Germany.

On July 5, 1818 in Montgomery County, Ohio, Frederick Beachler and Anna Frantz were married by G. W. Miller, j.p.

Anna Frantz was born in Virginia in 1791.

Frederick and Anna bought 80 acres of land in Clay Township, Montgomery County, Ohio. Their farm was a little southwest of Arlington and southeast of Bachman, both small villages. The Arlington Cemetery was started in 1851, and the Bachman Cemetery was started in 1836. Neither cemetery has record of the graves of Frederick and Anna Beachler.


Frederick and Anna were members of the Lutheran Church. Many of their children became members of the German Baptist Brethren Church.

Frederick died about 1855, middle aged.

Anna died October 17, 1871, aged 80 years, of sinking chill, in Clay Township, Montgomery County, Ohio, a widow.
