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

Your letter, addressed to the Historical Society of Muhlenberg County, was delivered to me.

I might state that my ancestors, together with the Gish family, came from Botetourt County, Virginia and settled near the village of what is now Bremen, Kentucky in north Muhlenberg County.

In 1913 Otto A. Rothert wrote, and published a "History of Muhlenberg County". This publication became very scarce and valuable and about one year ago I, with two other fellows, caused a reprint of this history to be made. We have a few more copies of this history available, which we are selling at \$15.00 per copy.

I find in this history a story about Christian Gish coming to Muhlenberg County, and according to this story he was killed by a team of horses crossing the Cumberland Mountains. His wife, and her seven sons, brought the corpse with them and he is buried near Bremen. In this story they did not mention any daughters, they mention only the seven sons. However in the same area where the Gish family settled they started a burying ground, there is a France family. Altho I have known members of the France family all of my life I have never heard where their ancestors came from to this county. Perhaps they were the same family to which you are inquiring about. There lives in Bremen, Kentucky now Elbert France who might give you this information if you would write him. I am,

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THESE REGIONAL BOOKS COULD HELP YOUR SEARCH Genealogical book publishers continue to offer valuable books of interest to researchers. Among some recent ones that may aid in your quest to find ancestors are:

o Tennesseans in the War of 1812, by Byron and Samuel Sistler. (Available from Byron Sistler & Associates, PO Box 120934, Nashville, TN 37212; 449 pages, hardcover, \$43 postpaid.)

This book is an alphabetical listing of all persons who served in Tennessee units in the War of 1812.

What You'll Find [NEXT]

Tennesseans in the War of 1812 contains about 33,000 entries, and gives name, rank, names of commanders, branch of service and other information. Since the earliest Tennessee federal censuses are for 1820 and 1830 (for the eastern part of the state), this book is particularly useful in establishing an ancestor's presence and location in this state at this early period.

Almost all the men named in this book were involved in actual campaigning, serving in the Creek War of 1813-24 (a sub-conflict of the War of 1812) or in the New Orleans campaign that culminated in a US victory in 1815.

Digging in Vermont? [NEXT]

Ironically, most deaths of these Tennesseans were the result of an apparent epidemic of some unknown malady after the war was over--in the early months of 1815.

o Vermont Families in 1791, edited by Scott A Bartley. (Available from Genealogical Society of Vermont, Vermont Families Project, PO Box 422, Pittsford, VT 05763-0422; 281 pages, hardcover, \$33.50 postpaid.)

Vermont has been called the crossroads of New England, as it attracted settlers from all over New England and New York. Research in this state presents challenges to amateur and professional genealogists alike.

This first volume of what will be a multivolume set to be published over many years is a veritable dictionary of all families enumerated in that first federal census, with biographical and genealogical details from primary and secondary sources, submitted by experts on each family and carefully exited by the project director.

If your families were among these 14,983 families enumerated officially in 1791 (although it is known as the 1790 census), when Vermont was admitted as a state, this is an exciting new source to consult.

o Kentucky Ancestry: A Guide to Genealogical and Historical Research, by Roseann Reinemuth Hogan, PhD (Available from Ancestry, Inc, PO Box 538, Salt Lake City UT 84110, softbound, 388 pages, \$22.45 postpaid.)

Kentucky played an important role in our country's western expansion, and for those with "blue grass" roots, this book provides an extensive guide to genealogical and historical records.

The author has outlined the holdings of the Kentucky State Archives, as well as various libraries, courthouses, universities and historical organizations.

Index for Louisiana Series [NEXT]

Chapter 6, "Special People: Kentucky Women and African-American Families," offers excellent tips for such research, including lesser-known records such as the oral history projects of universities.

The First Families of Louisiana Index, by Donna R Mills. (Available from Mills Historical Press, 5245 Caldwell St,

Naples, FL 33962, \$17.50 postpaid.)

This is an 89-page index to The First Families of Louisiana, by Glenn R Conrad--a major reference work for genealogists and historians delving into the colonial history of French Louisiana.

Washington, DC Wills [NEXT]

The author has prepared an every-name-and-place index to Conrad's original 2-volume set that will enable researchers to more easily find mention of early Louisiana ancestors.

Index to District of Columbia Wills, 1801-1920, by Dorothy S Provine. (Available from Genealogical Publishing Co, 1001 N Calvert St, Baltimore, MD 21202; 218 pages, softcover, \$28 postpaid.)

This alphabetical name listing of more than 22,700 wills filed in the District of Columbia Orphans' Court (probate court) during this period mentions the wills for a variety of people, some of whom where quite famous or notorious. African-American Wills Included [NEXT]

While the vast bulk of the wills were penned by white middle- and upper-class property owners, a substantial number was created by Washington's prosperous African-Americans.

This new publication can be a valuable source if you are seeking ancestors in this locality.
