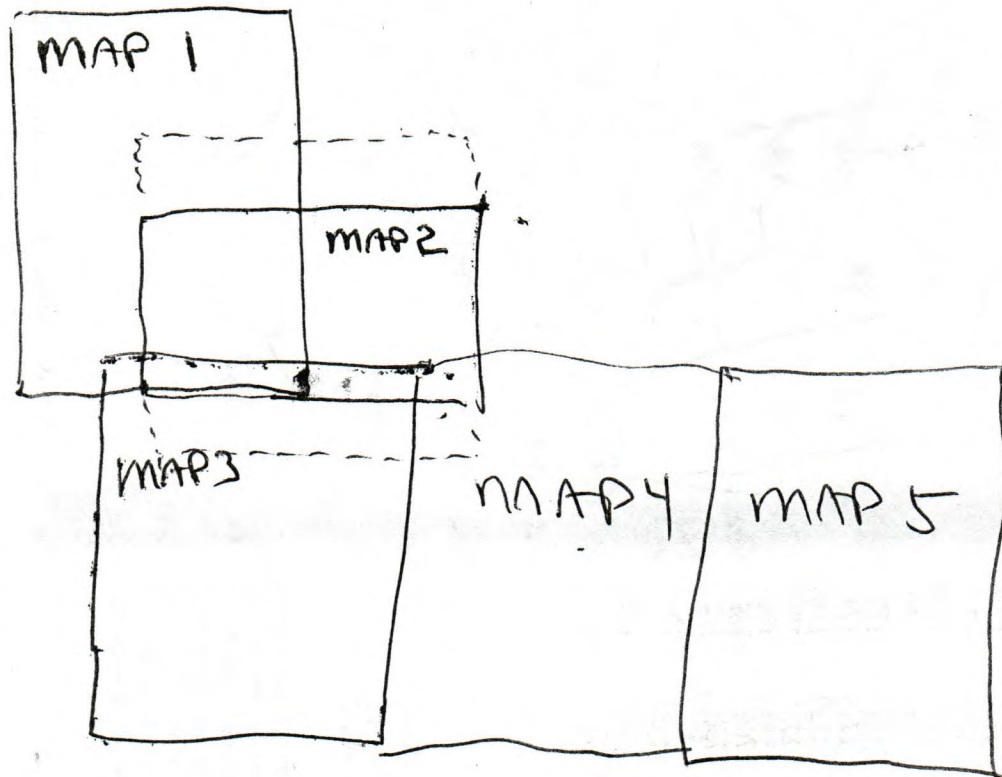

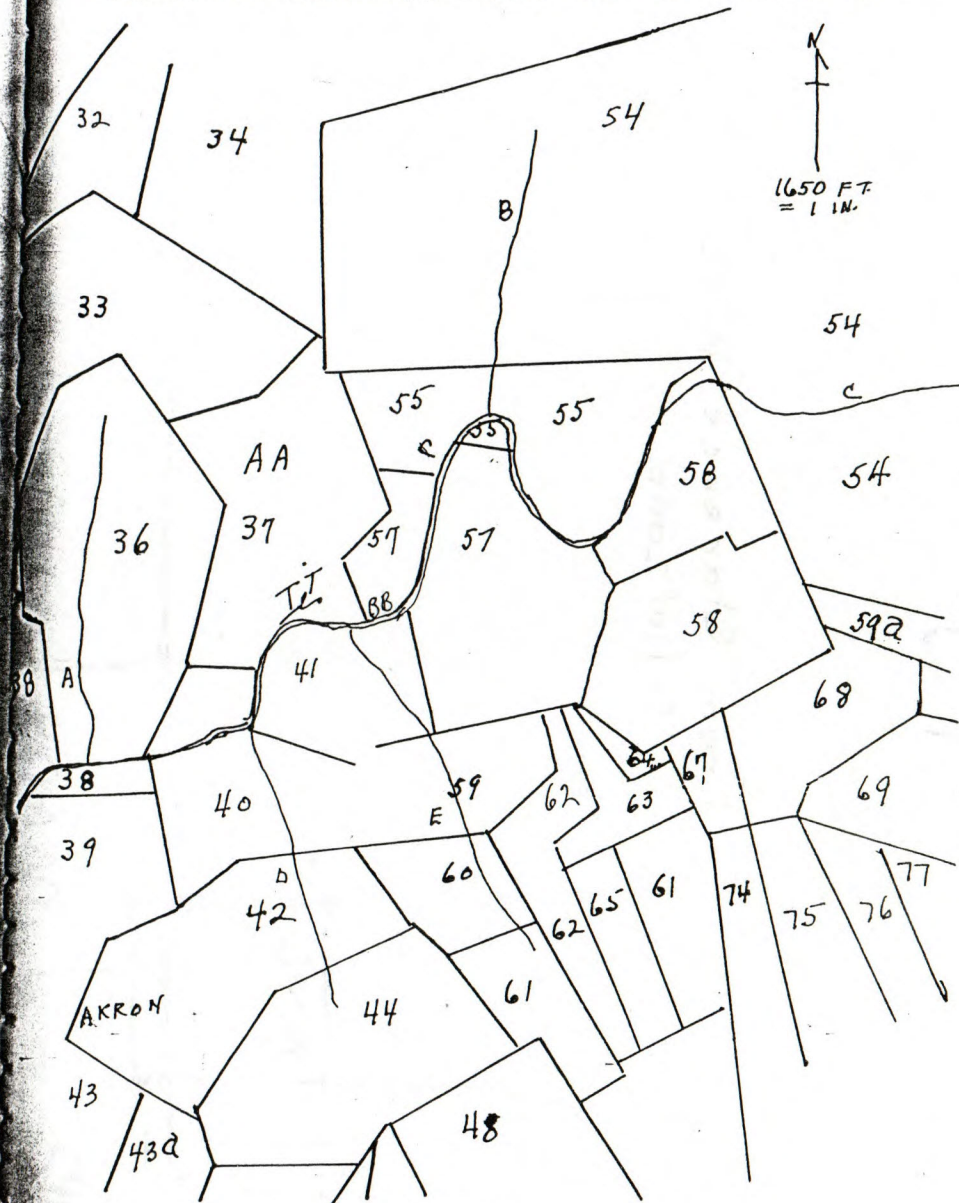

The years which are underscored show that the survey was made earlier than the date the warrant was issued. This is not the usual procedure; the warrant was issued and sent in with an application for a survey and the Surveyor's Office then made the survey at their convenience. These tracts may have been warranted earlier to other persons who did not meet the requirements and the warrants were voided and were later warranted and patented to the persons shown on the accompanying map, the grants being based on the original surveys.

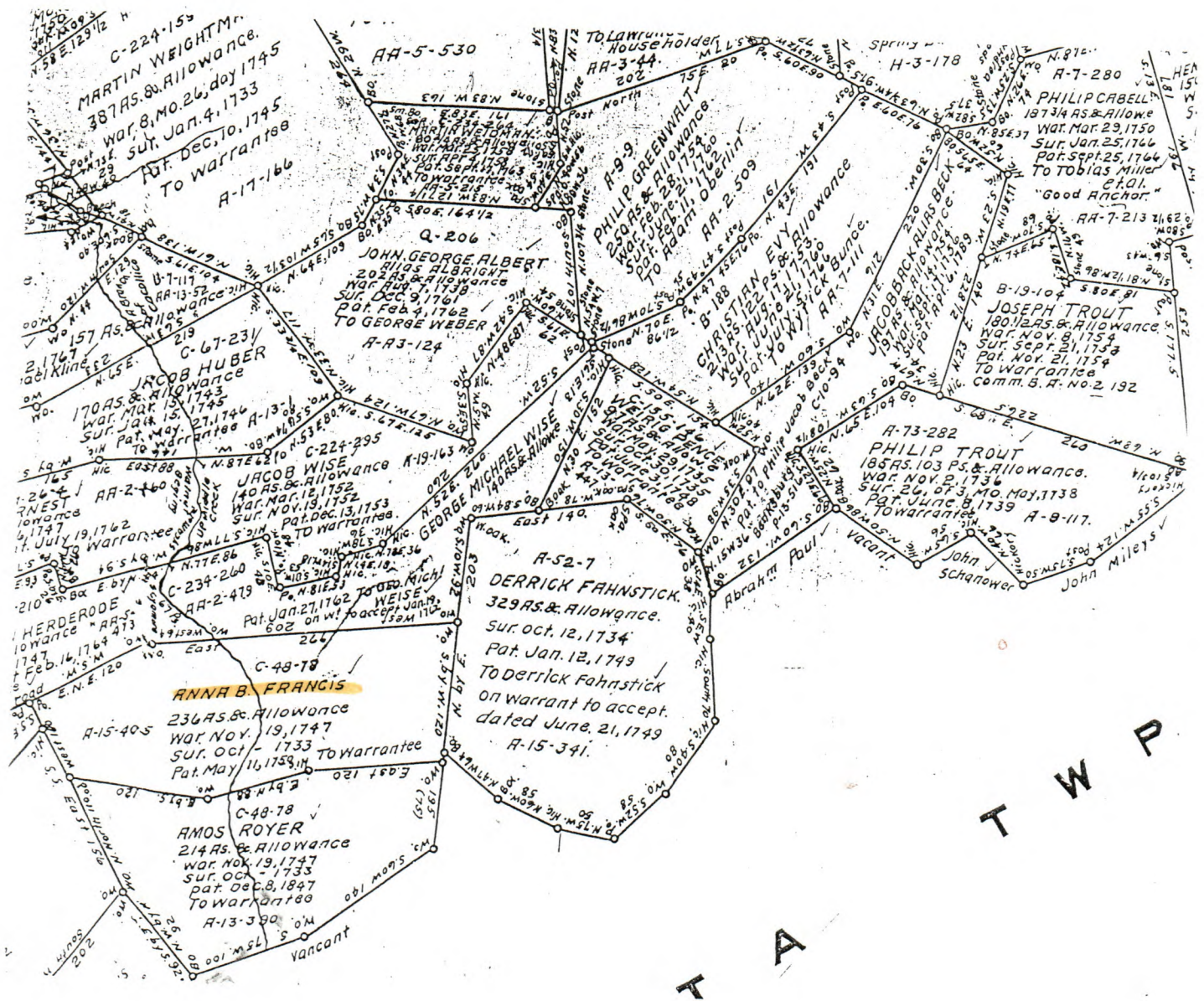

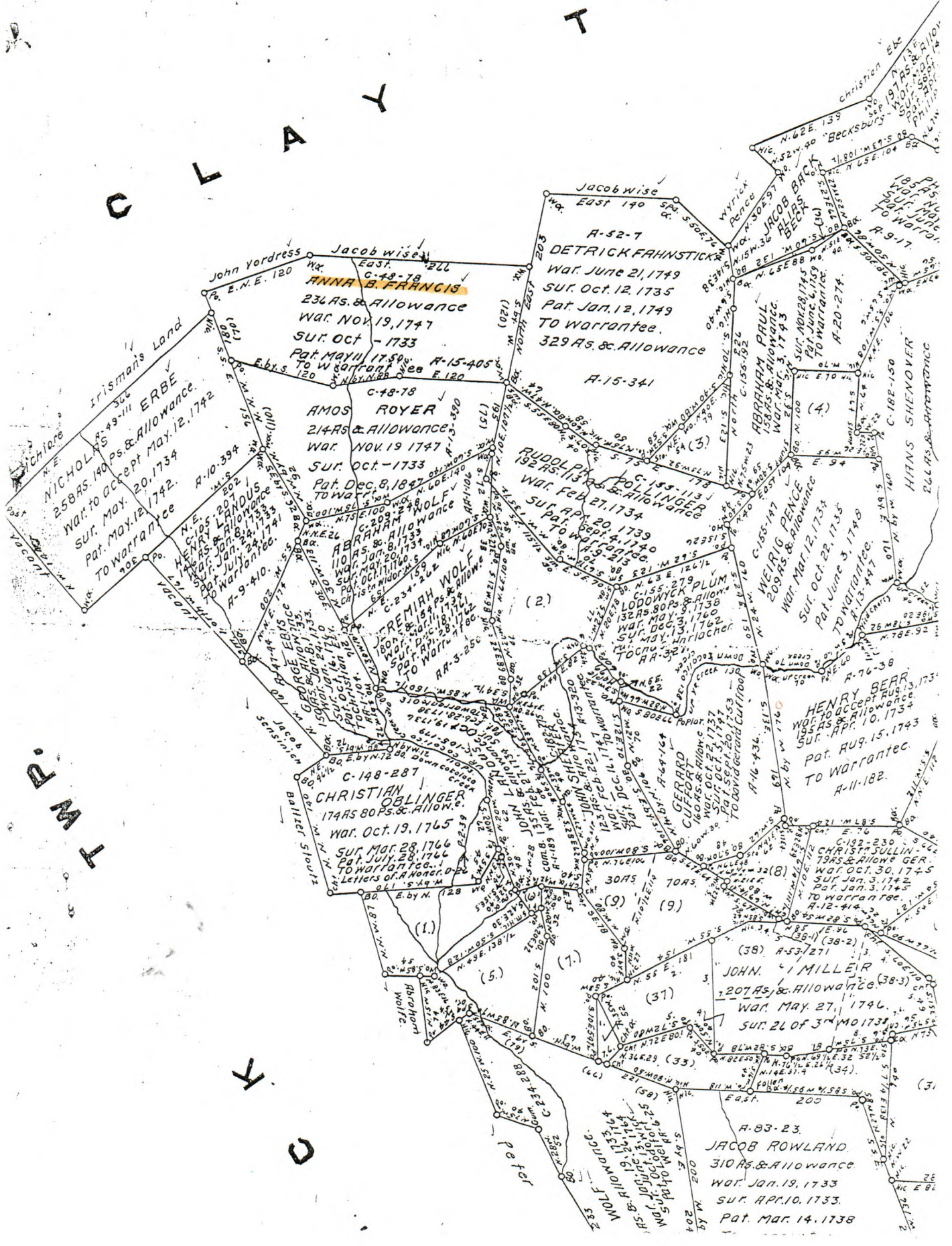
