was kept silent until the Curtis children were taken out of the  
home on 15 Jan. 1924. Children that were admitted into the Home  
on 18 January 1921, were: Ada Curtis, age: 17; Willis Curtis,  
age: 16; Matilda, age: 11; Viola Curtis, age: 7; and Alonzo, age: 4.  
They were given to the custody of their mother, Dora,  
after she remarried to Oliver Bolender ca. 1920-24.



The children were put into the Home because of the marital problems David and Dora were having between them. The last time that David and Dora were together, David used a rifle and beat Dora. She suffered a damaged ear and that marked an end to the marriage of long suffering abuse. Divorce was obtained by Dora Curtis on 28 September 1920, case no.#47468. At the time of the divorce proceedings, David K. Curtis was serving time at the County Jail for domestic violence to Dora Curtis.
