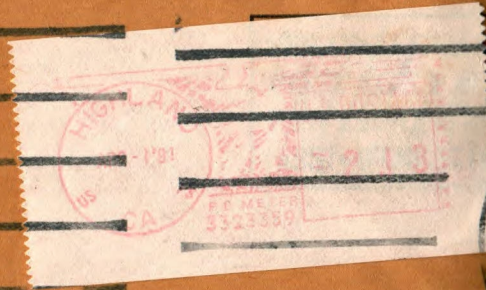

Isaac Frantz, although born in Clark County Ohio, crossed over the county line at an early age, with his parents to Miami County Ohio. The family attended the Hickory Grove congregation of the German Baptist Brethren Church. Isaac attended the local schools, and with advanced study became a teacher. He taught school for a few years, then purchased a large farm on "Hog Path" Road, and became a successful farmer.

In March of 1882, he was called to the ministry, and ordained to be an elder July 31, 1909. According to Flory, "because of a tragedy in the family about this time, he left his farm home and moved to the State of Florida. After spending two years in Sebring, Florida, he moved to Covington, Ohio. In April 1919 he became associate pastor of the Covington Church and the following June he was elected Presiding Elder." (Flory p.191)



Continuing from Flory, "Elder Frantz was considered one of the early church evangelists, conducting evangelistic meetings in many states. His fellow ministers considered him second to none in this field to which he had devoted much of his life.

"Elder Isaac was considered one of the church leaders of the General Brotherhood. He served on the Book and Tract Committee, as well as a short time on the General Mission Board.

"His life was that of service to the church, and after many fruitful years his life's journey came to an end. His earthly remains rest in the cemetery at Covington, Ohio."

---

Homer and Blanche were members of the Church of the Brethren. They moved to California around 1920. Homer had a wholesale hay company.

Robert Emerson Frantz lives in LaVerne, CA. He was a salesman for his father's hay business. He served in the Combat Engineers in WWII, overseas 1944-45.

Betty Lou Frantz resides in San Francisco (1986). She was divorced in 1963. Harold McNamee m. 2) Mary Sylvia Massey on 28 Nov. 1964. They have two children: Harold James McNamee II b. 4 Apr. 1966 and Mary "Sylvia" McNamee b. 1 Mar 1968.

"Their house (Nancy and Samuel Studebaker) is still standing (1985) and lived in by their descendants. Across the road from that house, is the cemetery where Jacob and Phoebe Studebaker Frantz are buried." by Ann Stephens  
Nancy and Samuel are buried in the Studebaker Cemetery in Miami Co OH.

Benjamin Studebaker married Naomi Funderburg, daughter of Abraham Funderburg and Sarah Keplinger, and granddaughter of Jacob Funderburg and Eve Boone.

Lydia Studebaker married Henry Gump, son of David Gump and Margaret Studebaker. Henry became a minister of the Church of the Brethren in 1880. He was a good musician and became known for his wonderful singing. They lived in Covington, Miami Co OH, and were the parents of eight sons and two daughters. One son John B. Gump, also a minister, married Emma Funderburg, daughter of Anthony K. Funderburg and Susanna Heck.

Jacob and Susan Studebaker Coppock lived in Miami Co Ohio. "In 1879, Jacob was called to the deacon's office and two years later he was elected to the ministry. His early education had been slight but by much reading and study he became what one would call a self-educated man. He entered into the field of his new calling and was soon recognized as a church leader in the district.

"He was considered one of the leading church evangelists but when the elders body of the district recognized his loyalty and leadership, he was advanced to the highest office by ordination.

"His services were not only to his local congregation but to the adjoining churches and the district at large. He served as presiding elder of the Covington Church for seven years; over the West Dayton Church two years; over the East Dayton Church five years; the old Loramie Church four years; the Middle District Church three years, and for a term of twenty years in his home church, from 1905 until his death August 11, 1925." As to the larger fields of service to the Brotherhood, he served the district on the Board of Trustees of the Brethren Home; six years on the Board of Trustees of Manchester College, and through his sponsorship on the District Board of Education the District Sunday School Institute was inaugurated.

"His unique personality endeared him to the old and young alike." (Lest We Forget p.314-315)

Henry and Kathryn Senseman Studebaker lived in Miami Co Ohio. They had three sons and three daughters.

Isaac Frantz Studebaker - called Francis Studebaker (Neher) Isaac and Mary had 10 children and with Ella 7 more. Ella was 34 years younger than Francis and a first cousin once removed. (Neher)

"Francis Studebaker was a farmer owning several farms in Miami & Clark Counties in OH at the time of his death. In 1897 Francis emigrated to New Rockford, ND where he took up a land grant issued by Pres McKinley & he homesteaded 2,500 acres raising almost entirely wheat. In 1901 he sold the ranch & returned to New Carlisle, OH. The bill of sale included 48 head of work horses, 5 wheat binders, 2 threshing rigs, 2 water wagons & 1 kitchen wagon. Ella (Neher) Studebaker worked as a restaurant waitress. Francis & Ella were members of the Ger/Bapt/Ch later known as the Ch/Brethren.

"Francis Studebaker died 1 month 20 days after his 7th child was born to Ella. Ella continued raising the family by herself on the farm near New Carlisle working as a waitress. On 6/30/1933 she m. Bill Staver & the family lived in N Manchester, IN. Seven years later, Bill Staver died. Bill & Ella had no children of their own. Ella then lived a widow for 30 years." (Neher p. 221).



Samuel F. Stuebaker lived in Miami County Ohio. He retired to New Carlisle. Samuel belonged to the Church of the Brethren and served many years as a Sunday School teacher, as well as Sunday School superintendent. His service to his local church was as church treasurer for many years. He served the Southern District of Ohio as a member of the Brethren Home Board from 1920 until his death. He had three children by his first wife: Roy, Verda and Paul and two by his second wife, Warren and Rieber.

Joseph Filbrun<sup>St</sup> moved to Montgomery County Ohio when a small boy, with his parents in oxen pulled wagons in 1829. Joseph and Lydia moved to Macoupin County around 1864. In the fall of 1887, they returned to Ohio.

Joseph and Lydia hosted the Annual Meeting of their church on their farm in Illinois in the year 1874.

Joseph was killed when his horse and buggy was hit by a train and he is buried in the Stillwater church cemetery near Dayton Ohio. Joseph and Lydia had 15 children. When the father died, four lived in Kansas, one in Missouri, three in Illinois, and five in Ohio. Two died as infants.

Peter Brubaker married first Catherine Crist in Clark County Ohio. She died soon after the birth of her second child, Catherine, b.8 Jan 1865, d.8 Mar 1865. Her first child, Hester, b.23 Jul/Sep 1862, d.22 Jul 1928, married 10 Oct 1880 Joseph Shavely in Gage Co NE and they had three children.

Peter then married Elizabeth Filbrun and they moved to Macoupin County Illinois by 1871. They were in Gage County Nebraska by 1879 and in Kansas by 1884, probably Anderson County. They left two little children buried in the Holmesville Nebraska Brethren Cemetery.



Jacob Filbrun and Nancy Beckner Lived in Kansas although one source said Indiana. They belonged to the Old German Baptist Brethren Church as did both of their parents who were deacons in that church. Children: Henry, John T., Elizabeth Lydia, and Jesse. Their son Henry Joseph was an elder for the church and lived at Cedar Creek Kansas. His daughter, Martha Filbrun, married Floyd W. Beckner, son of Levi Peter Beckner and Martha Plunkett, daughter of Moses and Sarah Filbrun Plunkett, making Martha and Floyd second cousins.

---

Sarah Filbrun and Moses Plunkett. They lived within the bounds of the Pleasant Hill Church in Macoupin Co. Illinois, Gage County Nebraska near the Centerview Old German Baptist Brethren Church, and at Anderson Co. Kansas. Moses was an elder for the Old German Baptist Brethren Church, ordained in 1903. He last served the Cedar Creek church in Anderson Co. Kansas. Their children were: Etta, Caperna, Martha, Emma, Clara, and Lydia.

---

Henry H. Filbrun. Henry lived in Ohio. He was an elder for the Old German Baptist Brethren Church at Stillwater, Ohio. They hosted the Annual Meeting on their farm in 1904. He was ordained 1898. His children were: Jesse, Perry, Ida Mae, and Everett Filbrun.

---

Isaac and Mary Filbrun lived in Macoupin Co Illinois within the Pleasant Hill congregation of the Church of the Brethren. When the Valentine Stutzman family had a seige of the typhoid fever, Isaac and Mary helped to nurse them, and arranged a calendar of nursing services among the Brethren community. (Weddle p.188)

---

Jonas and Susan lived in California. Their children were: Della, Mary Ellen, Ida May, Clarence J., Ethel Grace.

---

Weddle says of Lavinia, "Here another woman will show her talent for good business in a day when women are supposed to know nothing of business. Lavina will sell her coal rights. She will build a large new house. She will raise four daughters, all becoming valuable Brethren workers. She will care for her husband, who suffers a tragic illness through long, long years. She will deposit money in the bank and will be known as a wealthy Dunker woman whose business ability is second to none." p. 147.

Mike Flory, her second husband, was an elder for the Church of the Brethren. "Michael Flory is always to be known as a 'good preacher'. He settles in Girard, farms some, works in the lunberyard, but more and more gives his full time to evangelistic work and the paid ministry of the district mission board. 'My greatest hope,' he will often say, 'is to see the church grow in spiritual power, progressing as the problems of mankind require.'" Weddle, p.134.

---

Benjamin F. Filbrun was a minister for the Church of the Brethren. They lived near Auburn Illinois, and served in the Sugar Creek Church. Their daughter Leona Ellen Filbrun married Frank Webster Gibson son of Charles C. Gibson and Susan Neher. Frank was a minister for the Church. He and Leona went as newlyweds to Miami New Mexico where they served as missionaries and community helpers for 35 years.

---

Joseph J. Filbrun was a minister for the Church of the Brethren. They lived in Illinois, near the Great Bend area of Kansas, and later to Minnesota, Washington State, and by 1930 in LaVerne, California.

---

Peter F. Filbrun lived near Eaton Ohio.

---

Martin Filbrun lived near Dayton Ohio.

---

Levi Filbrun lived in Illinois.

---

Daniel F. Filbrun lived at Ft. Laramie. Ohio.

Mary Catherine and Daniel Barnhart Hirt began their family in Clark County Ohio. Daniel's first wife was Rebecca Neff whom he married in Sep 1861 and who died the same year. Daniel and Mary Catherine were chosen as deacons for their church. When the church divided, they joined the Old German Baptist Brethren. When a group of church members decided to go to Anderson County Kansas, they chose to go along. In the Spring of 1886 a group of about 20 left for their new home. Elizabeth Crist and some of her family were in the group. Her son Ezra had already married Susannah Hirt, Mary Catherine's oldest daughter, and in a few years, Elizabeth Crist's daughter Elizabeth would marry Mary Catherine's son Ezra. Mary Catherine and Elizabeth Crist were first cousins, although Elizabeth was 21 years older.

A few years before leaving Clark County, Daniel and Mary Catherine had lost three children, all in the same year. Little Elmer at only four years old had died in Jan. In February, they lost Irvin only 2. Later in October Elizabeth age 15 also died. All three are buried in Myers cemetery in Clark County. In a few years in Kansas, son John died when only 18 years, leaving 4 of their children to become adults.



Three of Daniel and Mary Catherine's sons became ministers of the Old German Baptist Brethren Church and served at Cedar Creek Church or Willow Springs Church in Kansas.
