FAMILY TREE: WALLBORN

Johann Adam Wallborn and his wife Anna Elisabetha do not appear in any of the six ship lists of 1709 reprinted in Knittle's Early Palatine Emigration. They do, however, appear in the New York Subsistence Lists: 1710, four adults and three children under age 10; 1712, five adults and two children under 10. They are also listed in the Simmendinger Register (ca. 1717) as still living in New York State: Hanss Adam Wallborn, wife Anna Elisabeth, and six children.

The name of Adam Wallborn appears among those who signed the petition for a road from Oley to Tulpehocken, presented to the Court of Quarter Sessions at Philadelphia in Sept., 1727.

The six children of Johann Adam and Anna Elisabetha Wallborn:

1. Andreas. Birthdate unsure. Marriage not known. Two sons recorded in the early Tulpehocken Church.
2. Christian Wilhelm. Born ca. 1692. Md. 1717 New York Catharina Elizabetha Batdorf, sister of Martin Batdorf. Died 11 Dec. 1769 Tulpehocken. Twelve children known.
3. Maria Elizabetha. Baptized 25 Oct. 1696 Wiesbaden. Md. Martin Batdorf, date unknown but later than 9 June 1716 (on which date they appeared, both single, as co-baptismal sponsors in the Kocherthal Records of West Camp Lutheran Church). Living 1767. Martin Batdorf d. 20 Feb. 1782. Published lists of children vary.
4. Christina Elizabetha. Baptized 20 July, 1703 Wiesbaden. Md. 15 Dec. 1721 New York State George Loesch. Died 17 Dec. 1782 Gnadenthal Pa, where he died 15 Aug. 1790. Eleven children. She is in PA records as Anna Christina.
5. Johann Hermann. Baptized 29 Jan. 1708 Wiesbaden. Md. 20 July 1728 Maria Margaretha Feg, daughter of Johannes Feg. Died 10 Jan. 1747. Eight children. Records of old Rieth's Church call him Hermanus.



6. Maria Catherina. Born about 1709. Md.  
6 Oct. 1730 Peter Schell.

The three children of Johann Adam Wallborn and his wife Anna Elisabetha for whom baptismal dates are given (Maria Elisabetha, Christina Elisabetha, Johann Hermann) were all baptized in Wiesbaden. The two oldest children were not baptized in that church (die Evangelische Gemeinde in Wiesbaden), nor is the marriage of Johann Adam and Anna Elisabetha in those records. There is no evidence whatever that Anna Elisabetha was a Feg, or has been reported elsewhere in print.

A footnote to an article, "The Registers of Reed's Church, " by Frederick S. Weiser and Vernon Nelson, appearing in the Historical Review of Berks County, Vol. XXXI, No. 1 (Winter, 1965-66), gives a possible source for this assumption. Footnote 5, page 27, begins: "Herman Walborn was a son of Johan Adam Wallborn, who is listed as a Hoffman of the Schutzenhof near Wiesbaden in the records there. His wife was a daughter of Johannes Feg and wife, who were from Idar." The words "his wife" refer to the wife of Herman Walborn, not Johann Adam, but have perhaps been misunderstood.

Hank Jones, expert on the 1709ers, has more information on the Wallborns than is given here -- including the marriage of Johann Adam, and his parentage. Members are invited to write Mr. Jones at P.O. Box 8341, Universal City, CA 91608.

The editor has lists of the children of Christian Wilhelm, Maria Elisabetha (Batdorf), Anna Christina Elisabetha (Loesch), and Johann Hermann/Hermannus, mostly with marriages and all with dates, but does not vouch for their accuracy.

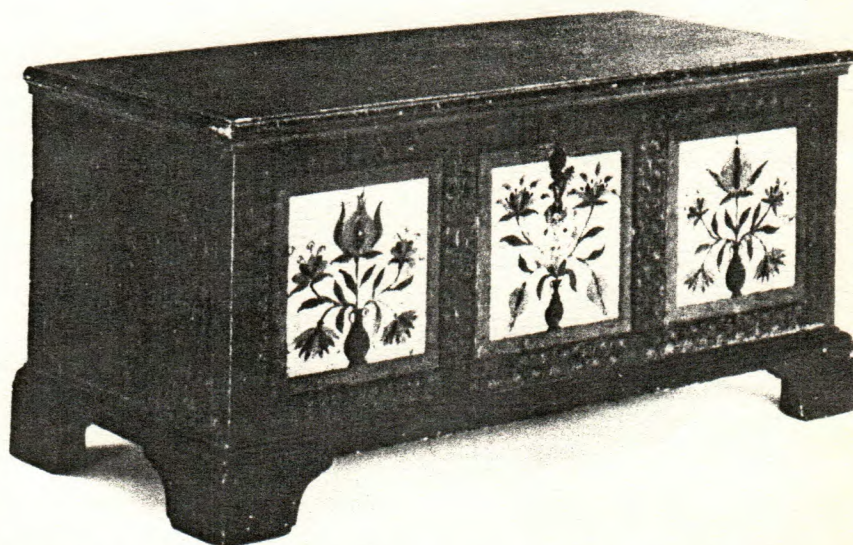

Known as Christian, he eventually settled in Jonestown, Lebanon County, where he was a joiner. The chests he made and decorated were among the first pieces of decorated furniture to be recognized by collectors of Americana. The chest here is signed by Seltzer and dated 1796.

MARRIED 1748

1. James Macssi, widower, and Margaretha Edison, widow, both from Lancaster County, Township. Married the 31st of May 1748 in my room in Dr. Adams' house, in the presence of several deacons and church councilmen, the schoolmaster, and three English men, etc. For my greater security Macssy [sic] was required in advance to bring me a note of permission from Master Thom. Cookson according to which they were twice proclaimed in the church here publicly on the 1st and 2nd Pentecost.
2. David Klnzel and Charlotta Stiessen from Manner [Manor] Township, June 19, 1748 in the church.
3. Johann Peter Buch and Anna Maria Schneiderin, July 26, 1748, after public proclamation three Sundays and a wedding sermon on Jeremiah 32: 38-41 in our church with a good gathering. The engaged and married persons are from Lancaster, the bridegroom Reformed, but the bride Lutheran.
4. Adam Leitner and Anna Barbara Barthen, Johann Georg Barth's daughter, August 23, 1748 on the father's plantation. They were publicly proclaimed three times within four weeks, once in Earltown [New Holland] and twice in Lancaster and before the wedding received a short marriage sermon on 1 Cor. 14:19-20.
5. Philipp Henrich Seng and Maria Magdalena, widowed Eppelmannin, from Lancaster, Publicly proclaimed three different Sundays, twice in Lancaster and once in Earltown [New Holland], and were publicly married on the Thirteenth Sunday after Trinity, September 4, 1748, in the church here in the afternoon after Kinderlehre [children's instruction.]

6. Joh. Peter Goetz, Reformed, and Anna Christina, widowed Graben, were proclaimed once Tuesday and today, the Fourteenth Sunday after Trinity, twice in succession; and were married in the afternoon after Kinderlehre with the permission of our church council and deacons, September 11, 1748.

7. Antoni H8flich and Maria Veronica Barthen were proclaimed on two different Sundays and once here during the week in the church and married on September 13, 1748 after a marriage sermon on Eph. 1:3.

8. Robert Makefarland junior and Esther D8n, both from Tonecal [Donegal] Township, were proclaimed the first time in Earltown [New Holland] on the Sixteenth Sunday after Trinity and on the 27th of September 1748 thereafter married in my room in the presence of Adam Simon Kuhn, Bernhard Hubele and many English people of both sexes.

9. Peter Schneider from Tonecal [Donegal] Township and Rebecca Bohnin from Hempfield Township were publicly proclaimed three different Sundays, once in Earltown [New Holland] and twice here in Lancaster and were married on Tuesday after the Seventeenth Sunday after Trinity, the 4th of October 1748 after a short marriage sermon on Psalms 13:6.

10. William Diky and Marry Willison from Setsbourry [Sadsbury] Township, Chester County, were publicly proclaimed three different times, twice in Lancaster and once in Tulpehocken and thereafter married on October 11, 1748 in the presence of many English people in my room.

11. Johann Daniel Maidinger and Anna Catharina Geigerin from the Schuylkill were publicly proclaimed three different times and married on the Nineteenth Sunday after Trinity, October 16, 1748, in the church.

12. David Whilly and Marry Ellid from Lancaster County, were publicly proclaimed three different times and married October 31, 1748 in my room.

13. Philipp Dietrich Huber and Regina Franckin from Strasburg Township were publicly proclaimed three different times and were married November 1, 1748 in the presence of their parents and brothers and sisters and various other people in my room.

14. John Leferty and Martha Graik from Deurry [Derry] Township publicly proclaimed three different times and married November 8, (1748).

15. Adam Schneider, a widower from Lancaster, and Anna Maria, widowed Schmidtin, from Lancaster, proclaimed once specially and then twice in succession, and married November 15, 1748 in my room.
