Joel Fullhart,

One by one the sturdy oak trees fall by the wayside, one by one the grand old patriarchs lay down in dignity and in serene peace the acceptor of life which has become only a burden to them.

Joel Fullhart was born in Virginia, Mar. 13, 1820, moved to western Ohio when about three years old where he lived approximately nineteen years. From there he moved to Indiana in the spring of '39. From Indiana he moved to Iowa living in Henry, Lee and Keokuk counties.

His marriage to Miss Nancy Mc-
bank of Tennessee in 1843 began a
companionship of over half a century
in these more than fifty years were
born to these estimable people fourteen
children of whom but two sur-
vive Marion Fullhart and Mrs. Eliza
Harris.

He moved in 1862 to Putnam
county Missouri and located on the
Mullins land near Omaha he made
his final move in '04 to the place
which for nearly fifty years had been
his home.

In 1896 the companion who had
so long shared his toils and pleasures
passed from his life leaving the
sorrows which only the vacant
chair can bring. In these intervening
years he dwelt in the old home
under his granddaughter's care and
attention brightened the declining
years. Beginning life with two strong
hands and a brave heart his life is
an example to young men of what
can be accomplished by honest, ear-
nest, persistent effort. One scarcely
knows which to most admire, his stur-
ness of character, his gentle dignity
or his childlike kindness of heart.

which prompted him to conceal a
gift in the giving as he has been
known to do.

He was the last of twelve children
and died of blood poison at the old
Fullhart homestead on June third
1912 age 92 years 2mo and 21 days.
He leaves 32 grand children 44 great
grandchildren and 2 great great grand-
children to mourn his death. After
a brief ceremony at the house the
long funeral procession slowly wound
its way to Concord church where an
exceptionally strong sermon was
preached by Rev. W. M. Rehman aft-
er which the body was laid to rest
in the Concord Cemetery.
