Vol. 1, p. 37 has Hans Frantz (T 1718) and T 1718
"refers to the Conestoga (later Lancaster) Tax record for the year 1718. Because most immigrants arrived in America in the fall, the taxes were collected in most cases before the fall, people listed on the 1718 Lancaster County Tax list probably arrived in 1717." (+ quote from p. 30)
