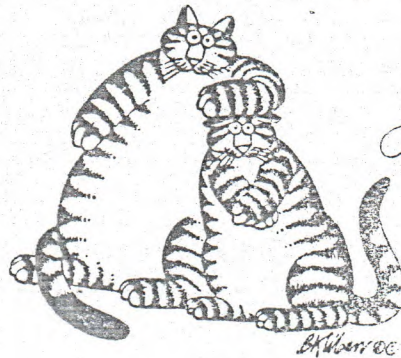
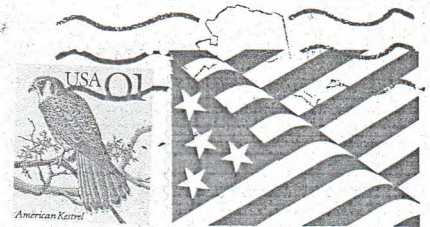

I received your postcard - and checked my computer data base and a couple of other resources. Sorry, I didn't find those names.

Here is a clue: If ~~the~~ ^{your} Skiles family have Old German Baptist Brethren (church denomination) in their ancestors then they are probably part of the families that I have and/or am aware of. The OG BB are "plain" people like Amish and Mennonite. They wear a very distinctive garb; usually are farmers in various parts of the U.S. (Modesto, CA for one).

In 1881 there was a split in the brotherhood and some went "progressive" and are known as Church of the Brethren. Maybe you already know all this!? If OG BB or Ch/Brethren is in the family, I can send your info to another researcher who may be able to help. We'll need more info than four names and no dates.
