#### INTRODUCTION

JOSEPH FLETCHER DEATON 1856-1941 and MARY CLEMENTINE ELLER 1858-1925 FAMILY

### DEATON

Several people throughout the United States are researching the DEATON family. We are indebted to them for some background material including the wills of John and Levi, sr. Deaton. DEATON name originated in England. Variations of spelling are: Dyghton, Deighton, Deeton. The name was probably taken from Dykestown, meaning a town with a ditch. In America other spellings are: Dayton, Deyton, Daton and Datton.

Records show that William Deaton sailed from England in 1640 on the ship "Assurance". He is said to have landed North Hampton, Virginia on January 1, 1641. The first Deaton of our line was in mid 1700's. We don't know if our line connects to this William.

<u>Levi</u> Deaton, sr. died 1799; his will is dated 20 April 1799. He married Martha Cady (last name not verified). Suggested birth years are 1748 for Levi and 1753 for Martha. She died 13 April 1822 in Botetourt County, Virginia. He died in Amelia County, Virginia. They had 9 children:

This essay will explore the origins and identify the first generation descendants of Jacob ELLER, wife Magdalene, who settled in what is now Roanoke County, Virginia, in the last decade of the eighteenth century. By doing so it will address two questions of concern to Jacob Eller descendants. The first is that of his ancestry. What is known of him, his wife, and their family backgrounds? How is Jacob Eller related to other ELLER families? Secondly, the paper will explore early connections of the Jacob Eller family with the Church of the Brethren, known popularly in the nineteenth century as "Dunkers" but more formally as German Baptists. At question is when the family became associated with the Brethren. As will be noted later, the problem of Jacob Eller's origins and the family's Brethren identity are not unrelated. These are questions which should be addressed before a definitive Jacob Eller family history can be compiled.

Defining Jacob and Magdalene Eller in historical terms presents problems typical of research in early German-American family history. There are few existing church records of family papers. Legal documents which might be helpful are often vague

or nonexistent. Spelling was not standardized in the early nineteenth century and diminutive forms of names ("Rebecca" and "Becky" to cite a clear example) were used interchangeably. Family tradition about certain ancestors is unclear, inconsistent, and in many cases lost.

It seems clear that the name ELLER is of German origin and means literally "one who lives near an alder tree" (German: <a href="Erle">2rle</a>), or it may have some connection with the noun Elle which means a yard, as in a unit of measurement. The E-l-l-e-r spelling has remained remarkably standard, although variations including E-l-e-r, A-l-l-e-r, and E-l-l-o-r have been found in records referring to a Jacob Eller descendant. There are literally scores of persons (and a few place names) with the E-l-l-e-r spelling in West Germany today. Eller immigrants continued to come to the United States well into the nineteenth century so that there are numerous ELLER families in various sections of the country who appear to have no connection with the Roanoke County, Virginia, family.

The problem of identification for Jacob Eller begins in America as early as the mid-eighteenth century. Between the 1740s and 1810s no fewer than twenty adult E-1-1-e-r males (this spelling) immigrated to the colonies and the newly formed United States. Three of these had the Christian or given name of Jacob. These are: Johann Jacob Eller, ship "Sally," December 31, 1772 and Jacob Eller, snip "Favourite," September 5, 1785--both of whom took the oath of allegiance in Pennsylvania; and a Jacob El-

ler who arrived in North Carolina in 1765 and took the oath there. Presumably many of these families were related, although there is no definitive ELLER family study. Interesting too is the fact that although many of these families came into the county through Philadelphia, few remained in Pennsylvania. There are only scattered references to Ellers in Pennsylvania records before 1800. The 1790 census reveals that only one Eller family lived in the state (Germantown, Philadelphia). Apparently most moved south. There are three E-1-1-e-r households in Maryland (two in Washington County) and eleven in Rowan County, North Carolina. Unfortunately, there are no existing 1790 or 1800 census returns for Virginia. Page 1800 census returns for Virginia.

Back to Jacob and Magdalene Eller. Family tradition is rather strong three brothers arrived in Pennsylvania, presumably from the Rhine Valley of Germany (Rhineland or Palatinate) before 1800. With other German immigrants they made their way south down the Blue Ridge mountains into Virginia.

Jacob settled in what was then Botetourt County (created from Augusta in 1769-1770) while the two unnamed brothers continued south and settled in North Carolina. This tradition, while never thoroughly studied, is plausible in that there clearly was a major migration of Germans from Pennsylvania into Maryland and down the Blue Ridge into the Carolinas, beginning in the early decades of the eighteenth century. According to an ELLER genealogy published in 1925, three ELLER brothers—Jacob, Christian, and Melchior—do appear to have settled in Rowan

County, North Carolina in the 1760s. Details concerning their travel route and point(s) of departure, however, are lacking. This Jacob Eller died in Rowan County in 1782. Another, younger Jacob Eller is picked up in the 1790 census who continued to live in western North Carolina well into the nineteenth century.

In addition, there were two Jacob Ellers who, assuming them to have been young men when they landed in Philadelphia, would have been of the approximate age of the Virginia Jacob. Our Jacob is enumerated in the 1810 census for Botetourt County.

Both he and wife are shown as over age 45, meaning that they were born sometime before 1765. The household at that time consisted of six children: a female between 16 and 26, a male and female between 10 and 26, and two males and one female under age 10.5

The "three brothers" tradition was briefly presented in The Jacob Eller Family Tree (Salem, Va., mimeograph, 1948) by Henry C. Eller, now of Bridgewater, Virginia. This brief but important study was put together from information collected and preserved by his father, Christian E. Eller, and others. This family tree has been used by genealogists of related families such as BRUBAKER, BARNHART, and FLORA. While The Jacob Eller Family Tree is incomplete and contains some minor errors, it still provides the core of what is known about early Jacob Eller descendants.

One of the genealogists who used Henry Eller's 1948 compilation was James W. Hook. Hook was a descendant of a North Carolina ELLER family (Virginia Eller and James Hook, married in 1867) and in several publications endeavored to trace various

Michael Eller and Descendants of His in America (New Haven, Conn.: for the Author, 1957) is a thorough updating of the earlier publications and is based on considerable research. By including Henry Eller's material, however, Hook created a past for Jacob Eller totally outside the Virginia family's tradition.

Briefly, Hook theorized that our Jacob was a younger son of George Michael Eller, a German immigrant who died in Frederick County, Maryland, in 1778, but who had earlier lived in western North Carolina where the other ELLER families had settled. His will names several children, including his "youngest son Jacob" who was given the family Bible. Three of his known sons, Peter, Leonard, and George, all lived in North Carolina.6

The evidence for Jacob Eller of Virginia being the son named in George Michael's will is circumstantial, but hardly conclusive. Jacob would have been of the approximate age to have been a younger son, that is, born in the 1760s. And, Frederick County, Maryland, records to indicate that a Jacob Eller was active there in the 1790s. He married Mary Willjard in 1792, voted "Federalist" in the presidential election of 1796, and is enumerated there in the census of 1800. By the 1790s, however, our Jacob was well established in Botetourt County, Virginia. Hook believed the Frederick County Jacob to have been a son of Henry Eller (d. 1788 in Frederick County), whom he suggested was a brother of George Michael. 7

In support of his theory that the Virginia Jacob was a son

of George Michael Eller, Hook cites the westward movement of David Eller, an older son of Jacob, to infer a relationship between the two families. Unfortunately, David Eller has been completely lost from the Virginia family tradition and was therefore not recorded in The Jacob Eller Family Tree. Extensive but unpublished research by Charles E. Martin between 1978 and 1980 demonstrates that David moved from Virginia to Montgomery County, Ohio in the mid 1820s, to Preble County, same state in the mid 1830s, and from there to Hamilton County, Indiana, sometime in the late 1840s.<sup>8</sup>

Hook learned of the existence of David Eller through a reading of Jacob Eller's probate records, census returns, and from a brief reference to him in a Hamilton County, Indiana, history published in 1915. David's move west did parallel somewhat that of Leonard Eller, a known son of George Michael. He moved from North Carolina to Miami County, Ohio in 1801, and from there to Hamilton County, Indiana in 1834. Hook's inference is that David followed his "uncle" Leonard both to Ohio and Indiana. Such conjecture is not without merit, except that there is nothing in deed, probate, census, or other records which prove that the two men nad any financial ties, or that they even knew each other. 9

There are other problems with Hook's theory concerning the origins of Jacob Eller. For example, three of Jacob's Eller's daughters still living in 1880 and enumerated in the Federal census that year indicate a belief that both parents were born in Virginia. If Jacob were a son of George Michael, he would more

likely have been born in Maryland or North Carolina. Furthermore, Jacob's son David was born c1782 (according to a now lost grave marker), and David's children believed that he too was born in Virginia. This means that there is a rather strong family tradition which places Jacob in Virginia far earlier than Hook's theory would allow.

Finally, there is a weak argument from silence. George Michael's Bible, important enough to be mentioned in the 1778 will, is not in the possession of any known Jacob Eller descendant, nor is there any known family tradition about such an important book. Given the family's strong ties to the German Baptist Brethren in the following generation, surely it would have been preserved. A Bible is not mentioned in the Jacob Eller's will or in an inventory of articles in his estate which were sold in 1830.

Unfortunately, for the present, Jacob Eller's background remains unclear. There simply is no hard evidence to support Hook's belief that he was a son of George Michael Eller. It does seem probable, however, that he was related in some way two one or more of the Carolina ELLER families.

The background of his wife Magdalene does help resolve the matter. That her name was Magdalene (or Magdalena/Magdalen/Magdalen) is without question since it appears with Jacob on an early deed record in Botetourt County. Some family researchers have suggested that her maiden name was PETERS, and indeed, this is the name recorded on the family record in the Latter-day

Saints church archives.<sup>11</sup> Documentation of her family name is circumstantial at best. There is no known recorded marriage of Jacob Eller to a Magdalene of any name before 1800 in Pennsylvania, Maryland, Virginia, or North Carolina. Obviously, more research on her background which need to be undertaken before a full Jacob Eller family history can be completed.

The land records of Jacob Eller in what is now Roanoke
County (created from Botetourt in 1838) are helpful in locating
him. As mentioned previously, the earliest first known reference
dates Eller in Roanoke County in the 1790s. On July 19, 1790,
the Commonwealth of Virginia conveyed to him 150 acres on "Wolf
Run, a Branch of Back Creek." This tract was apparently part of
a land warrant originally issued to one John Minter [or Minten?]
in 1788. Minter assigned a portion of the warrant to Humphrey
Smith, who in turn assigned it to Eller. A few years, in 1804,
Eller sold this same property to his in-law, John Brubaker for
\$500.12 Research to date has not been able to locate "Wolf Run"
or the 150 acre tract. It may well have been located in Franklin
County (created in 1787).

The farm which until a few years ago was known as the "Eller homeplace" was conveyed to Jacob Eller from Jacob Yest in 1799. Located approximately seven miles southwest from the county seat at Salem, on the "headwaters of Cravens Creek," this property of 470 acres was part of survey originally granted by the Commonwealth of Virginia to Thomas Harrison in 1790. Harrison sold a portion of this grant to John Harris, who in turn sold it to

Yest. Yest had it resurveyed, then sold 470 acres of it to Eller for \$1165.67. His title was not recorded until 1802.<sup>13</sup> The "sheepskin deed" (land grant) which contains a survey description of the property patented to Harrison has remained in the Eller family until the present.

Jacob Eller also acquired an additional 49 acres next to the Cravens Creek land on "Mudlick, a Branch of the Roanoke." This was obtained from the estate of Abraham Statler, deceased, in 1819, although Eller was not a Statler heir. 14 This brought his real property to approximately 519 acres.

The only other land transaction known to involve Jacob Eller is intriguing, but vague. In 1814 the Commonwealth of Virginia, under a newly enacted law, moved to collect back taxes of \$3.25 on 400 acres which Jacob Eller owed for the years 1797 and 1798. The location of this property is unknown, as are the details as to when and how Eller acquired it. The tax could have been on the Cravens Creek farm. Eller may have rented here prior to purchase in 1799 and part of the now lost purchase agreement was to pay taxes owed by Yest. The Back Creek property to which he then did have title, consisted of only 150 acres, and it was transferred in total to John Brubaker in 1804. In any event, the county Deputy Sheriff certified to the Commonwealth "that no property could be found," and declared the 400 acres legally for sale in a Richmond newspaper. Fifty acres was sold in August, 1814 for \$3.45 to Frederick Garst, who was subsequently given a Sheriff's deed, recorded May 21, 1817. 15 What makes this transaction even more unusual is that Garst was Eller's son-in-law, he having married Susan Eller in 1809.

There are few family traditions about Jacob Eller. It is assumed that he farmed but he also may have liked to hunt, and if so was probably absent from the family and farm for long periods. It is entirely possible that he spoke both German and English and he could apparently sign his name in English script. Local records have him being appointed "overseer of the road" in 1799. According to a C. E. Eller statement, Jacob's two story house (cabin?) stood on the homeplace close to where his son Abraham and later his son J. W. Eller built homes. 16 Interestingly enough, in 1805 Jacob Eller sold to Michael Danner various household and kitchen furniture, "shop tools used for making wagons," as well as a stud horse and cow, apparently in an attempt to settle a debt.

When Jacob Eller prepared his will in May of 1830 he had sufficient real property to make a detailed beguest to his wife and and children. Since the will and the settlement of the estate provides the clearest identification of his children, it merits careful attention. His wife (unnamed) was allowed to remain in the house where they lived "throughout her natural life," half the garden, a clock, two beds, a cupboard, table and other furniture and household items, a mare, saddle and bridle, and \$200 in cash. Two sons, John and Abraham, were to equally divide his "plantation" of "about five hundred acres" after it was surveyed, each son posting an appropriate bond. John, also

an executor of the estate, was to receive that portion of the division on which he then lived. Abraham received various farming implements. An unmarried daughter Rebecca received various household items, including a spinning wheel, a saddle and bridle, a cow and a calf, as well as \$50 cash. Further, it was Jacob's desire that she live with her mother during her lifetime "and if she thinks proper to remain after the death of her mother in the house where they both occupy and is to have the use of the upper room in the said house so long as she conducts herself decently." Finally, Eller directed that his remaining personal property be sold at a public sale and that the proceeds be distributed equally among his children and wife. To be included in this distribution were the heirs of Susan Garst, deceased, wife of Frederick Garst. 18

The sale was held November 12, 1830, which meant that Jacob probably died sometime in early fall. The location of his grave and that of Magdalene, death date unknown, has not been preserved. Both are probably buried on the family farm. 19 According to estate administration papers filed in January, 1840, his real property was valued at \$2,538.17 and a division of \$239.99 paid to nine heirs, including Magdalene. These heirs were:

Henry Brubaker, wife Sarah: Frederick Garst, Peter Himley, wife

Nancy: Isaac Wertz, wife Rebecca: David Eller: Daniel Peters, wife Elizabeth; Abraham Eller: and John Eller. 20 These then, are the known children and grandchildren of Jacob Eller. They are arranged in order of marriage, not in order of birth:

1. DAVID ELLER, c1782-1858; m. 1) Anna Brubaker, 1785-1825 on December 21, 1802 in Franklin County, VA; 2) Elizabeth Foutz (1825), and 3) Mary Martin (1827), the latter two in Montgomery County, OH. Anna Brubaker was a daughter of John and Anna Myers Brubaker who moved to Franklin County in 1781 and to whom Jacob Eller sold land in 1804. David Eller moved to Ohio in the mid 1820s, then to Hamilton County, IN in the late 1840s. He is not in the 1850 census and died without a will or property (intestate). Several children in the 1850 census are enumerated in other households, Preble County, OH. Children by Anna Brubaker:

James Hook also suggests another son, Jacob, based on the fact that a second Jacob Eller, age 26-45, appears in the 1820 census for Botetourt County. His household consisted of a female over 45, a female 26-45, three males under 26, and a female under 16.23 Our Jacob in 1810 had a male "under 10" that cannot be explained in terms of known sons. However, this child is clearly not old enough to be the second 1820 Jacob. The 1810 male could have a son that did not survive or the child of a relative. In any event, the second 1820 Jacob is not in the 1830 or census for Botetourt County and is otherwise unknown. Hook and Henry Eller also list a daughter Magdalene based on the fact that she received an equal share of Jacob Eller's estate. As noted earlier, however, this is Eller's wife, not daughter.

## The ELLERs and the BRETHREN

Having thus identified the children of Jacob Eller a second

task is to explore the early relationship of this family to the Church of the Brethren. Between 1800 and 1980 many descendants in the next four or so generations have had close ties to the Brethren, not only in Virginia, but in the Midwest, Kansas, and the Pacific Coast states as well. For example, among Jacob's direct male Eller descendants (sons David, John, Abraham) there are nineteen ordained ministers. This list is easily doubled when the female lines of BRUBAKER, GARST, and WERTZ are added. Literally hundreds of Eller descendants have served the Brethren in others ways: local church offices (deacons, moderator, and clerk), church school teachers, national and district committees and staff, volunteer service workers, missionaries, even college faculty. How did this relationship of the family to the Brethren begin?

The origins of the German Baptist movement may be traced back to eighteenth century Germany. Early Brethren were Protestant dissenters who for good conscience believed they could not remain within the state churches of Europe (Lutheran, Reformed). They developed out of the Radical Pietism, a reform effort that sought strengthen the evangelical fervor and spiritual life of the state churches. Brethren were also strongly influenced by the Mennonites (Anabaptists) whose emphasis on nonresistance (biblical pacifism), separation of church and state, living simply, community life, and nonconformity reflect the sixteenth century Radical Reformation. 25 In America the Brethren became known for their unique form of trine immersion baptism, love

feast (communion) with feetwashing, plain dress, and refusal to participate in military service.

The ELLER name is not found in existing lists of Anabaptist martyrs or in extensive compilations of early Mennonite families which have been made for Switzerland, Germany, and Holland.

There were ELLERs involved in eighteenth century Pietism. Perhaps the most well known of these was Elias Eller of Elberfield. In 1727 he and his wife founded a mystical, millennialist sect, but because of persecution this group was forced to an estate some thirty miles distant. Here the group founded what is today the city of Ronsdorf, a name by which Eller's sect was also widely known. While Elias Eller's views were somewhat extreme, dissention among the sect's leaders following his death in 1750 forced the congregation back into the conformity of the state Reformed Church. 26

It is possible that many of the colonial ELLER immigrants to America were Pietists, perhaps without affiliating with either the Lutheran or Reformed Churches. Few ELLERs may be found in the baptismal or marriage records of these groups. James Hook was the first non-Brethren family researcher to associate the family with the German Baptists, the first group of whom who arrived in America in 1719. Still, there are no ELLERs mentioned among the scant records of the Brethren in either Europe or Colonial America. A Henry E-1-e-r was baptized in the Conestoga congregation, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, in 1747.<sup>27</sup> Hook believed this same Henry Eller later lived in Frederick County,

Maryland, and was a brother of George Michael Eller. Some of the early western North Carolina ELLERs do appear to have been associated with Carolina Brethren, although the history of the congregations which existed there is extremely sketchy. 28

In Southwest Virginia the picture is brighter. As sectarians, Brethren generally settled in family groupings. By the late eighteenth century, a few such clusters had developed, the earliest on the Blackwater River in Franklin County (1760s) and a second in the Amsterdam/Daleville area of Botetourt County (1780s). Jacob Eller, along with clearly identifiable Brethren related families such as the Brubakers were located between these two in what later became Roanoke County. The dates when these settlements developed into congregations is not known, but meetinghouses were built at Peters Creek (Roanoke County, 1845), Germantown Brick (Franklin County, 1848) and Botetourt Valley (Daleville, Botetourt County, 1851). Prior to this the Brethren met in homes for worship, generally once a month.<sup>29</sup>

Whether Jacob or Magdalene Eller were actually Dunkers will probably never be known. If not baptized members, they were certainly in close contact with the Brethren in that several of their children married into Brethren families. Their son John and five grandsons became preachers; two granddaughters also married men who were placed in the ministry. The frequent marriages of Jacob Eller children and grandchildren into Brethren families, and the leadership which these families provided the church, strongly suggest that the Ellers affiliated with the

Brethren in Roanoke County at an early date. Indeed, local tradition is clear that the Brubaker, Wirtz, and Eller families were among the early members of the Peters Creek church. John Eller, whose ordination probably dates from the late 1840s, would have been among the congregation's first ministers. Whether Jacob and Magdalene themselves came from Brethren homes before settling in Roanoke County is pure speculation.

The Oak Grove community in which sons John and Abraham resided is several miles to the south of the Peters Creek area. While the story of a Brethren church in this community more properly belongs to the twentieth century, it should be noted that a Brethren meetinghouse was built at Cave Spring, a few miles to the east, which dates from the Civil War. 31 It is reasonable to assume that Dunker services were held in the Oak Grove area, perhaps as early as the 1840s.

THE WILL OF LEVI DEATON, DATED JUNE 27, 1799: In the name of God amen I, Levi Deaton, of Amelia Co., Va., being weak in body but of sound mind and many thanks be to almighty God for the same calling to mind the certainty of death and uncertainty of this life do make and ordain this to be my last will and testament in manner and form following (that is to say):

First, I desire all my just debts to be fully paid. Item: My will and desire is that my executors hereafter named be authorized and empowered and I do hereby authorize and empower them to purchase any right or title to a tract of land known by the name of Vaysers and at present under my occupancy and that it shall be discretionally in my executors' power to do the same (or to make sale of all my land including the land I now live on with all my right and title to the said Vaysers Tract for the best price that can be had) and the money arising from such sale to be applied to the purchase of lands elsewhere or so much thereof as may be necessary for that purpose at the discretion of my executors and they are hereby fully authorized and empowered to make a conveyance to the same. Item: My will and desire is (provided my beloved wife Martha C. Deaton shall resign her right and dower to the above mentioned land if sold) that she have the use and benefit of all such lands as shall be purchased as above directed with all the remaining part of my estate real and personal deriving herein during her single life for the support and education of my children and after her death or marriage my will and desire is that all my estate real and personal be publically sold and equally devided among all my children (to wit: Elijah, John, James, William, Elizabeth, Levi, Martha, and George) and if my beloved wife Martha should bring a child or children within nine months from the date hereof, my will and desire is that it shall have an equal share with my children above named to them and their heirs forever. Lastly, I do constitute and appoint my friends James Meglassen, Samuel Farrar and Anthony Webster several executors of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of April, 1799. Signed and sealed by: Levi Deaton

At a court held for Amelia Co., Va. the 27th day of June 1799, this last will and testament of Levi Deaton, deceased, was proved by the oaths of Anthony Webster, and John Vasser, two of the witnesses thereto subscribed and ordered to be recorded. And at another court held for the same county the 26th day of Sept. following came James Meglassen, one of the executors therein named, and made oath and entered into bond with Anthony Webster his security in the penalty of \$2000 as the law directs. Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate in due form reserving liberty to the other executors therein named to join in the probate when they think proper. ### JOHN DEATON'S WILL:

I, JOHN DEATON, of the County of Roanoke, do make and publish this my Last Will and Testament, hereby, revoking and making void all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made:

As to such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to intrust me with, I dispose Of as follows (Viz.)

- 1st I direct that all my debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after me decease as possible. Out of the first monies that shall come into the hands of my Executors from any portion Of my Estate real or personal.
- 2nd I wish by land sold by my Executors as soon after my decease as practicable, and untill sold my son, FRANCIS ASBURY DEATON, is to have the refusal Of renting it; also I direct that all my perishable property be sold as soon as practicable, and that the proceeds of my land and property be divided equally between my six children, (Viz.) POLLY GOODWIN, ELIZA HORN, LITTLEBERRY HARDIMAN DEATON, SARAH TEMPLE, FRANCIS ASBURY DEATON and JOHN W. DAY, also I leave my family Bible to my son, FRANCIS ASBURY DEATON.
- I, John Deaton, having since the foregoing Will was executed, married LUVINA ELLER, between whom and myself there is a marriage Settlement on record in the Clerk's Office Of Roanoke County Court, and it being provided in said Settlement that the said LUVINA is to have no portion Of my Estate, except such as I may direct by Will or otherwise—And now wishing to bequeath to the said LUVINA, my present wife, the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, also one cow which she may make choice of, and that she have her support for the ensuing winter months after my decease, and do direct in my Will, before making distribution of my Estate amongst my six children, do pay to my said wife LUVINA DEATON the sum of two Hundred dollars, but this legacy to be void if I should survive her.
- 4th I do hereby make and ordain JOHN W. DAY and FRANCIS ASBURY DEATON, Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I, JOHN DEATON, the testator have to this my Will written on sheet of paper, set my hand and seal this fourteenth day of February in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty three.

# THEY WERE ALL AT HOME A Delightful Reunion of Mr. J. W. Deaton's Family.

On account of the continued illness of Mrs. Annie Deaton, with the advice of Dr. W. P. Norris, her eleven children were at once called home. As four of them resided respectively in Ohio, Missouri, and Texas, they were wired for and in a few day all were present and in their turn manifesting their parental love and care for the mother. The thought of meeting again and seeing another once more in this life made the return a very anxious one, but as they gathered home, every precaution was observed to prevent her becoming overjoyed and thereby causing heart failure, as one had not seen her in sixteen years. She being somewhat improved received them with a motherly affection and extended them a hearty welcome.

Mrs. Deaton having been married twice is the mother of fifteen children, fifty-one grand children, and seven great grand children, and is only about 73 years of age. Mr. Francis Asberry Deaton, her first husband, was born September 9, 1817, served six months in the Confederate army as a private soldier and died January 13, 1865, in Hollywood Hospital. Interment in the family burying ground. Of this union, nine children were born, six of whom are yet living namely:

J. A. Deaton, Wichita, Texas, aged 23 years; C. W. Deaton, Salem, Va., aged 51 years; J. F. Deaton, West Alexander, O., aged 49 years; Hester Campbell, Fristoe, Mo., aged 45 years; Dora Tyler, Roanoke, Va., aged 43 years; W. F. A. Deaton, Camden, O., aged 41 years.

Mr. John W. Deaton, her second betrothal, is now 67 years of age, served in the Confederate army four years and belonged to the Salem Flying Artillery. Of this union, six children were born—all living but one, namely:

Lettie E. Trout, Salem, Va., aged 39 years; H. R. Deaton, Salem, Va., aged 37 years; D. P. Deaton, Salem, Va., aged 36 years; J. T. Deaton, Roanoke, Va., aged 31 years; Nannie Trout, Salem Va., aged 23 years.

There are some record breakers in this circle. Mrs. Deaton's mother, Mrs. Mary Eller, if given a few more days—till March 31st—will see her 92nd birthday. Her two companions being Southern soldiers, her second companion forbiding a change in her name, yet not a brother of the first. Having one son weighing 345 pounds, and the seven boys averaging 200 pounds, while the four girls only averaged 152 pounds.

Mrs. Deaton being much improved and all the children in Virginia again, but not having all met at home for 26 years, January 2, 1906 was named as a reunion day. On the 3rd the eleven children were all present, with other relatives swelling the number to thirty-five only two not being related to Mrs. Deaton. The day was passing pleasantly despite the extensive preparations for dinner, and by one o'clock the dining hall with its cedar decorations, and a large extension table posed in the center almost refusing to bear its heavy burden, presented such a view that even one with a satisfied appetite would need a guard. Indeed, the variety, quality, and quantity made it an extraordinary, well-prepared and an up-to-date feast. It displayed skill in selection, preparation, and arrangement. All things in readiness, the sick mother was assisted to the table, and she with her husband sat as in years gone by, one at each end of the table, and the eleven children on either side. The hostesses were at their best, and gave to each one as he hath need, so for one long hour these 200 pounders, together with their more delicate parents and sisters, prayed upon this inexhaustible supply. After expressions of

gratitude for the entire satisfaction of their appetites, and for the privilege of once more meeting around the parental table, and to our Heavenly Father, the giver of every good and perfect gift, and to those who provided the occasion, gave opportunity for the second sitting. After all had fared sumptuously and spent a few hours vying with one another in expressions of love and merriment, song service became the next special feature of the day--such hymns as "Rock of Ages," and "When the Roll is Called Up Yonder," were voiced in such melody that one must say when all the singers get home what a wonderful, wonderful, singing there will be. As the singing continued, it resumed the attitude of a thanksgiving prayer service, interspersed with singing. The expressions of thankfulness were varied, each one thinking of something different, some having traveled through dangers, seen and unseen. Mother is better, and instead of sorrow and sadness in the home it is turned to joy and sweet association. A happy reunion! A favored day in my life and one that shall be cherished in memory as a spiritual feast as well as temporal. The wayward especially remembered, and then with strong and earnest petitions for the Holy Spirit to lead us into a higher and purer life, and a parting blessing to meet again in that glorious reunion, never more to part. "God Be With You Till We Meet Again" closed the services at a late hour. Soon parting hands were taken, the relatives and some of the children were soon scattered, leaving the mother not much wearied with the exercises of the day, and the invalid father overjoyed. The Western children began returning to their respective earthly homes January 3rd, and at this writing all are gone, and so far as heard from have landed safely home.

#### LETTER FROM JOHN W. ELLER TO JOHN C. BECKNER

<u>John W. Eller</u> was born 21 May 1836. He was the son of Abraham Eller, 1801-1868 and his wife, Mary "Polly" (Wertz) Eller, 1814-1908. He was the grandson of Jacob and Magdalena (Peters) Eller, and John and Anna (Frantz) Wertz.

John's parents had 12 children: Magdalena Barnhart, Sarah Neff, Annie Deaton, John W., Eliza Naff, Abraham, Christian, Daniel, Amanda (died age 21), Henry, Francis Asberry "Berry", and Nancy Catherine "Nannie" Brubaker.

John was married to Leah Barnhart. Leah was born 16 Nov 1836. She was the only child of Benjamin Barnhart, 1807-1848, and his wife, Nancy (Wenger) Barnhart, 1811-1895. (After Benjamin died, Nancy remarried to Michael Rettinger and had eight more children.)

John and Leah were the parents of five children:

- Lucy Madora Eller (1856-1924) m Josiah E. Brubaker. They had 9 children.
- 2. Mary Ellen (1858-1925) m Joseph Fletcher Deaton. They had 12 children.
- 3. Joseph (1861-1864)
- David Newton (1862-1914) m Alice Graybill. They had 6 children.
- 5. John (1864-1864)

Leah (Barnhart) Eller died 22 Feb 1865. During this time, John W. Eller was in Clark County, Ohio to escape the military during the Civil War, and while he was gone, his wife and two sons died. He returned to Virginia and resided at Cave Springs in Roanoke County. He was a minister in the German Baptist Church until his death.

John married again, to Hannah C. Brubaker. Hannah was born 25 Aug 1842. She was the daughter of John Brubaker (1811-1897) and his wife, Susannah (Flora) Brubaker (1816-1886). She was a niece to Elizabeth (Brubaker) Beckner and a first cousin to Josiah E. Brubaker, her step-son-in-law.

John and Hannah were the parents of nine children:

- Virginia "Jennie" Alice (1866-1946) m Moses Neher. They had 4 children. Virginia m 2nd David Ikenberry.
- Daniel (1868- ) m Sarah Ulery. They had 8 children.
- Christian E. (1870- ) m Rebecca M. Henry. They had 10 children.
- 4. Benjamin (1871-1921) m Emma Dillon.
- 5. Charles (1873- ). Died an infant.
- 6. Nannie (1876-1877).
- 7. Samuel H. (1878-1879)
- 8. Cora (1880- ) m Robert Breem. They had 3 sons.
- Sarah Elizabeth (1883- ) m John H. Wimmer. They had 8 children.

John W. Eller died 7 Mar 1899. His second wife, Hannah (Brubaker) Eller died 20 Dec 1902. This family was prominent in the Church of the Brethren except Lucy Brubaker. Her husband was a minister in the Old German Baptist Church, Peters Creek district, Virginia.

<u>John C. Beckner</u> was born 25 Jan 1824. He was the son of John Beckner (1799-1866) and his wife, Elizabeth (Cook) Beckner (1800-1887). He was the grandson of Abram and Christiana Beckner and John Cook, all of Botetourt County, Virginia.

John C.'s parents had 10 children: Abraham D., John C., Catherine Gish, Christena Brubaker, Susanna Brubaker, Jacob B., Benjamin, Mary Ann Riffey Frey, Daniel A. and Samuel O. Beckner. This family moved from Fincastle, Botetourt County in 1847-48 to Salem, Roanoke County. The parents are buried in the old Brubaker Cemetery in the Green Ridge community near Hanging Rock, Roanoke County.

John C. Beckner was married 29 Dec 1846 to Elizabeth Brubaker. She was born 28 Jul 1830, daughter of Henry Brubaker (1775-1848) and his second wife, Saloma (Eller) Brubaker (1787-1882). Elizabeth was the granddaughter of John and Anna (Meyer) Brubaker, Jacob and Magdalena (Peters) Eller. Her father had nine children by his first wife, Elizabeth Flora (1774-1809) and 10 children by Saloma. Elizabeth was the 18th child.

John C. and Elizabeth (Brubaker) Beckner moved from Virginia in 1859 to North Hampton, Clark County, Ohio. In 1864, they moved to Virden, Macoupin County, Illinois. In 1888, they moved to Anderson County, Kansas. They were part of the formative years of the Cedar Creek church district of the Old German Baptist Brethren Church.

John died 12 Aug 1889; Elizabeth died 21 Feb 1909. They were the parents of two children:

- Henry Beckner (1848-1921) m Elizabeth Riffey. They had 4 children. Henry m 2nd Susan (Neff) Clingenpeel
- 2. Nancy (1854-1937) m Jacob Filbrun. They had 4 children.

### John W. Eller wrote to John C. Bechner as follows:

Clark County, Ohio February 19, 1865

Dear Brother in the Lord, i have thought of riting to you for Several days and no opportunity until this morning though you are indebt to me one letter now but i hope you will pay up with interest i can inform you that i am well this morning with exception of a little cold the health is good here at present. the reffugees relations and friends are all well as far as now at present it is likely you would like to no something about the draft this township have made up all this money except 16 hundred dollars the Brethren i don't think put in any or but very few of them the Provost Marshall at Collumbus says if they put in any more bounty money they could not have the benefit of the Commutation law and the Brethren thought that they would hold on to the latter law their is some of the world say they will burn up their houses if they don't help make up the money but i hope the Brethren will not pay any Attention to it for the Lord will be with us if we do our duty towards him.

I suppose you now that Joel Barnhart has moved to the state of Mishigan and he has had very bad luck since he has been there his house and nerly every thing that was in it was burned to the ground he says that it would take about 35 hundred dollars to replace everything as it was they was all well when they note last | will

now tell you something about the weather—it is quite pleasant this morning their is some snow on the ground yet their has been a great deal of snow here this winter and cold to I have not been doing much this winter on the account of the bad weather—I am still staying at Phillips—I don't now what I will do after the weather sets in purty—I have no heart to do any thing, wheat is worth \$ 1.75 per bushel—corn is 95 cents per bushel oats 70. and other things in proporation, the Reffuggees have not been enrolled in this township yet it seams that this war is a bad thing to get through with thou I think and do hope this summer will wind it up in the place of people hungering and thirsting after righteousness—they are hungering and thirsting after cold blood.—I don't no what I will rite next—look on the other page.

Brother John I guess you would like to hear Some news from old virginia—i received a letter from some about a month ago and they was all well at that time and they rote that Father & Mother was well and sent their best respects to you and Brother Benjamin and all enquiring friends and want you to rite to them—i also received to letter from home friday evening. my son Joseph died the 23 day of November—he died with the croup—and my companion was sick—he res was well—Brother Asbury Deaton died the 19 day of January he died near richmon in the hossepittle—Brother John B. Naff lost his youngest chile some time ago and Sister Magdaline Brubaker daughter of John Brubaker died with the fever the date not given though I suppose it was in November. Hannah has also had the fever she is better—John i Should like verry much to see you and hear you talk once more—i am rite smartly troubled and some times think that i will go rite of home i dont no how muich longer i can stand it—though if i was their i could do them no good so long as this cruel war is going on, Daniels oldest chile is dead also—died the 11 of december.

i am looking for more letters from home every day for i now their is some on the way my wife says in her last letter that to common class people will certainly have to sell their land to pay their taxces. The times are hard there. I think that I will now close for the present I hop this may find you all well and I hope you will excuse bad riting and my takes for I am In no condition for riting after reading the sad news from home.

John I want you to rite soon and give me all the news. It is some consolation to hear from my "best friend", in these trouble some times and I hope you will remember in all you prayers.

Give my respects to all enquiring friend and receive a due portion to yourself. I subscribe myself your well wishin,
